Summer 2019 will be an exploration of the land, animals and culture of the Pacific Rim! Through activities, games and science experiments, the children will journey throughout this diverse and dynamic region of the world. In addition to our complete Montessori curriculum, each two-week session will be enhanced with a specific topic along with related literature, music and art. You may choose any, several or all sessions and a variety of schedules are offered for each session.



Session 1
June 17-28

Discovering the Unique Geography of the Pacific Rim

As we embark on our adventure, we will identify the regions of the world that make up the Pacific Rim. The children will identify various land and water forms, and will create their own versions of archipelagoes, peninsulas, oceans, rivers, lakes and even island countries. Our tour will span several continents and climates including our own Pacific Northwest, a geographical wonder!

Exploring the Pacific Ocean

We will demonstrate how the Pacific Rim countries are connected by the Pacific Ocean. During our nautical journey the children will encounter various ocean vessels, learn about currents, depths, ocean weather and how sea creatures have adapted to their environment. As we explore, we will discover migrating whales and a variety of beautiful sea life, unique to the Pacific Ocean, which provide food and trade for the western world. **THIS SESSION WILL BE HELD AT PINE LAKE CAMPUS ONLY DUE TO ROOF WORK BEING DONE AT HIGHLANDS CAMPUS. The Pacific Plate and the Ring of Fire

Volcanic activity is prevalent in the Pacific Rim. We will learn about the Ring of Fire and build our own active volcano, complete with demonstration! Tectonic plates, buried deep in the earth will come to life in our classrooms through active participation with models and practice in “drop and cover” drills.

Session 4

Pacific Rim Animals and their Habitats

As we journey inland, we discover mammals, birds, reptiles and insects that have adapted to their specific region. In the Northwestern United States and Arctic we see bears that reflect their environment. Asia is home to the endangered panda, tiger and Asian elephant. We will explore their habitats and discuss how we can protect the earth to provide a steady supply of food and a safe home for these unique creatures.

Cultures of the Pacific Rim

Our adventure allows us to take a closer look at the diverse cultures associated with the Pacific Rim. Specifically, we will compare and contrast food and clothing and learn about dwellings and customs of the Northwestern United States, Russia, China, Thailand and Japan.

In order for us to plan appropriate staffing and buy needed supplies, tuition for each session must be **paid in full** when you register and is **non-transferable** and **non-refundable**.
